The Town of North Topsail Beach is contacting you to remind you that there is an ordinance limiting the amount of time trash carts are allowed to be in the right-of-way. Trash carts shall only be in the right-of-way between noon the day before pick-up and 10:00 a.m. the day after pick-up. The ordinance was put in place to make sure that our Town looks its best for our property owners, residents, and visitors.

There has been an increase in the number of carts being left out too long. If you rent your home please make sure that the correct pick-up schedule is posted in the unit. Please also contact your rental company to see if they offer a service to ensure that the carts are pushed back in a timely manner. There is a fine associated with violating this ordinance.

Solid Waste Schedule

Peak Season

(first full week of May through last full week of October)

Wednesday & Saturday Mornings

Non Peak Season

(November through April)

Wednesday Mornings Only

Recycling Schedule

Wednesday Morning Year Round

Vegetation Pick Up Schedule

3 Times Per Year

(February, March, and November)

First two days of pick up will be north of Town Hall. Second two days of pick up will be south of Town Hall. Please have vegetation out for pick up by A.M. of the second day.

All grass clippings, mulch, leaves, straw and vines must be in paper lawn and leaf bags (available at local hardware stores). **NO PLASTIC BAGS WILL BE PICKED UP.**

Tree limbs must be no longer than 6 feet in length and no larger than 6 inches in diameter. All vegetation must be at the right-of-way for pick up.

Debris from lot clearing (ex. to build a home) is not included. Vegetative debris resulting from the hiring of a private contractor is the responsibility of the contractor. It will not be removed by Town Staff.

Acceptable Material - DO NOT BAG OR SEPARATE

Newspaper
Cereal Boxes
Shoe Boxes
Magazines
Junk Mail

Green, Brown, and Clear Glass
Corrugated Cardboard
Gable-Top Cartons (Milk Cartons)

Aluminum Beverage Cans
Aluminum, Steel & Tin Food Cans
Aluminum Foils
Plastics #1-7
Rigid Plastics (buckets, plastic toys, lawn furniture). Mixed rigid plastics must be under 2 feet in length and under 40 pounds, and fit in recycle cart.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE BROKEN DOWN AND FIT INSIDE CART

Unacceptable Material

Bagging material
Mirrors, window or auto glass, light bulbs, ceramics, antifreeze containers, plastic bags, coat hangers, paint cans, or any household items (toasters, cooking pots or pans, etc.)

Plastic cam shells, PVC pipe/tubing, vinyl siding, Styrofoam or polystyrene, plastic medical waste, and plastics that have come into contact with petroleum products and/or hazardous waste.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO PUSH YOUR TRASH & RECYCLING CARTS BACK BY 10:00 AM ON THE DAY FOLLOWING COLLECTION

PICK UP WILL TAKE PLACE EARLY IN THE MORNING. IT IS SUGGESTED THAT YOU PLACE CARTS OUT THE EVENING PRIOR TO PICK UP DAYS

TRASH OR RECYCLING LEFT OUTSIDE OF THE CART WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IF YOU FREQUENTLY RUN OUT OF ROOM ANOTHER CART SHOULD BE ORDERED

The Town no longer picks up bulk goods (appliances and furniture).

North Topsail Beach, NC Code of Ordinances

§ 13-7 PLACEMENT OF CONTAINERS FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION.

- (a) Containers shall be located in the street right-of-way only for the purpose of garbage collection. Rolling containers shall be clearly marked with the owner's street address.
- (b) Containers shall not be located in the street right-of-way earlier than noon on the day preceding scheduled collection and shall not remain within the street right-of-way after 10:00 a.m. on the day following collection.
- (c) Containers located within the street right-of-way at other times or not properly marked are in violation of this section.
 - (1) First offense shall receive a written warning.
 - (2) Subsequent violations of this section shall be punishable by a fine as specified in the schedule of town fees, per occurrence.
